## **Specific Conditions for Filling the Functional Positions of Professors at Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice and its Parts**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 15(1)(n) and the provisions of Section 12(1)(f) of Act No. 131/2002 Coll. on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments to Certain Acts, as amended (hereinafter the "Higher Education Institutions Act"),

**I hereby issue**

the following

**Specific Conditions for Filling the Functional Positions of Professors at Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice and its Parts (hereinafter the "Conditions")**

**PART I  
QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS  
APPLICABLE TO ALL PARTS OF UPJŠ IN KOŠICE**

**Article I**

1. The applicant must demonstrate the fulfilment of the criteria for the award of the scientific-pedagogical title of professor as specified in the standards of the habilitation and inauguration proceedings. If Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice has been granted the rights to conduct inauguration proceedings in the field of the habilitation and inauguration proceedings corresponding to the defined area of science and education, the applicant must demonstrate the fulfilment of the criteria valid at the university for the given field. If Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice has not been granted the rights to conduct inauguration proceedings in the field of the habilitation and inauguration proceedings corresponding to the defined area of science and education, the applicant must demonstrate the fulfilment of the criteria for obtaining the scientific-pedagogical title valid at another higher education institution in the Slovak Republic that has been granted such right. If Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice has been granted the rights to conduct inauguration proceedings in a field of the habilitation and inauguration proceedings that is defined more broadly than the area of science and education for which the functional position of professor is being filled, the applicant must meet the university's criteria applicable to that broader field of the habilitation and inauguration proceedings. If Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice has been granted the rights to conduct inauguration proceedings in a field of the habilitation and inauguration proceedings assigned to the study field within the area of education and science defined in the announcement of the call for applications for the functional position of professor, the applicant must meet the university's criteria applicable to that field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings.
2. The applicant must meet also other requirements arising from Act No.131/2002 Coll. on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments to Certain Acts, as amended, the General criteria for Filling the Functional Positions of Professors and Associate Professors at Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice, as well as these Specific Conditions for Filling the Functional Positions of Professors, in the field corresponding to the defined area of education and the defined area of science.
3. Meeting the criteria for filling the functional position of professor does not constitute a legal entitlement to be awarded the functional position.

**PART II  
PEDAGOGICAL ACTIVITY  
AT INDIVIDUAL PARTS OF UPJŠ IN KOŠICE**

**A) Pedagogical activity at the Faculty of Medicine of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice**

1. The minimum condition for the initiation of the procedure for filling the functional position

of professor is the performance of pedagogical activity for at least six years from obtaining the third-level university degree in the study programmes of the field of study to which the field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings is assigned.

Only the period during which the applicant has been employed by a higher education institution is taken into account as the performance of pedagogical activity, i.e. at least:

- a) three years for a shorter working time in the extent of at least 1/3 of the stipulated weekly working time (including abroad) or has performed pedagogical activity in the extent that corresponds to 50 % of the direct teaching standard of an assistant professor set out in the internal regulation of UPJŠ, and
- b) three years for a shorter working time in the extent of at least 1/2 of the stipulated weekly working time (including abroad) or has performed pedagogical activity in the extent that corresponds to 50 % of the direct teaching standard of an associate professor set out in the internal regulation of UPJŠ.

The applicant has performed pedagogical activity to the required extent and structure through some of the following activities and outputs:

- led lectures (including lectures of the compulsory course), exercises, seminars,
  - evaluated students, including at state examinations,
  - supervised and opposed final theses at the second and third level of higher education,
  - participated in designing the study materials, in the development of the quality of study programmes,
  - led gifted students of secondary schools and universities in subject clubs or competitions (e.g. subject Olympiads, high-school professional activities, student scientific professional activities),
  - led a team in educational development projects.
2. Demonstration that the applicant has participated in the development of education or a study programme through the outputs of pedagogical activity in the form of the creation of study materials (university textbook or chapter in a university textbook, teaching material, lecture materials or textual aid, educational film, e-learning course containing the content, distribution and management component of instruction in the relevant field of study, introduction of new units into the study programme, teaching software, and teaching aids).
  3. Demonstration of some other relevant activities related to education, e.g. by membership of professional committees, bodies and councils focused on higher education, lecture stays abroad of the total of at least 20 days (e.g. ERASMUS mobility – teaching), organization or professional guarantee of educational activities (workshop, exhibition, field trip, etc.), demonstrating the development of language, pedagogical or digital skills and competences, creating teaching case studies, awards for pedagogical activities, involvement in lifelong learning, conducting accredited courses, consulting attestation theses, etc.)
  4. The minimum threshold values of measurable indicators by individual fields of habilitation and inauguration proceedings are stated in Annex 1 hereto.

## **B) Pedagogical activity at the Faculty of Science of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice**

1. The minimum condition for filling the functional position of professor is the performance of pedagogical activity for at least three years from obtaining the title of associate professor in the study programmes of the field of study to which the field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings is assigned. Only the period during which the applicant has been employed by a higher education institution is taken into account as the performance of pedagogical activity, namely at least for a shorter working time in the extent of at least one half of the stipulated weekly working time (including abroad) or has performed pedagogical activity in the extent that corresponds to 50 % of the direct teaching standard of an associate professor.

2. Demonstration that the applicant has performed pedagogical activity to the required extent and structure through some of the following activities and outputs: in particular, has led lectures (including lectures of the compulsory course), exercises, seminars, evaluated students, including at state examinations, supervised and opposed final theses at the second and third level of higher education, participated in designing the study materials, in the development of the quality of study programmes, led gifted students of secondary schools and universities in subject clubs or competitions (e.g. subject Olympiads, high-school professional activities, student scientific professional activities), led a team in educational development projects.
3. Demonstration that the applicant has participated in the development of education or a study programme through the outputs of pedagogical activity in the form of the creation of study materials (university textbook or chapter in a university textbook, teaching material - lecture materials or textual aid, educational film, e-learning course containing the content, distribution and management component of instruction in the relevant field of study, introduction of new units into the study programme, teaching software, and teaching aids).
4. Demonstration of some other relevant activities related to education, e.g. by membership of professional committees, bodies and councils focused on higher education, lecture stays abroad of the total of at least 20 days (e.g. ERASMUS mobility – teaching), organization or professional guarantee of educational activities (workshop, exhibition, field trip, etc.), demonstrating the development of language, pedagogical or digital skills and competences, creating teaching case studies, awards for pedagogical activity, involvement in lifelong learning, conducting accredited courses, consulting attestation theses, etc.).
5. The minimum threshold values of measurable indicators by individual fields of habilitation proceedings and inauguration proceedings are stated in Annex 1 hereto.

**C) Pedagogical activity at the Faculty of Law of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice**

1. The minimum condition for filling the functional position of professor is the performance of pedagogical activity for at least three years at the functional position of associate professor in the defined area of science and education. Only the period during which the applicant has been employed by a higher education institution, namely for at least a shorter working time in the extent of at least one half of the stipulated weekly working time (including abroad) or has performed pedagogical activity in the extent that corresponds to 50% of direct teaching standard of an associate professor is taken into account as the performance of pedagogical activity. The applicant has performed pedagogical activity to the required extent and structure through some of the following activities and outputs: in particular, has led lectures, including lectures of the compulsory course, exercises, seminars, evaluated students, including at state examinations, supervised and opposed final theses at the second and third level of higher education, participated in designing the study materials, in the development of the quality of study programmes, led gifted students of secondary schools and universities in subject clubs or competitions (e.g. subject Olympiads, high-school professional activities, student scientific professional activities, artistic activities), led a team in educational development projects.
2. Demonstration that the applicant has participated in the development of education or a study programme through the outputs of pedagogical activity in the form of the creation of study materials (university textbook or chapter in a university textbook, teaching material, lecture materials or textual aid, educational film, e-learning course containing the content, distribution and management component of instruction in the relevant field of study, introduction of new units into the study programme, teaching software, and teaching aids).

3. Demonstration of some other relevant activities related to education, e.g. by membership of professional committees, bodies and councils focused on higher education, lecture stays abroad of the total of at least 20 days (e.g. ERASMUS mobility – teaching), organization or professional guarantee of educational activities (workshop, exhibition, field trip, etc.), demonstrating the development of language, pedagogical or digital skills and competences, creating teaching case studies, awards for pedagogical activity, involvement in lifelong learning, conducting accredited courses, etc.).
4. The minimum threshold values of measurable indicators for pedagogical activity are set out in Annex 1 hereto.

**D) Pedagogical activity at the Faculty of Arts of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice**

1. The minimum condition for the filling the functional position of professor is the performance of pedagogical activity for at least three years from obtaining the title of associate professor in the study programmes of the field of study to which the field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings is assigned. Only the period during which the applicant has been employed by a higher education institution is taken into account for the performance of pedagogical activity, namely for at least a shorter working time of at least half of the stipulated weekly working time (including abroad) or has performed pedagogical activity in the extent that corresponds to 50% of the direct teaching standard of an associate professor. The applicant has performed pedagogical activity to the required extent and structure through some of the following activities and outputs: in particular, has led lectures, including lectures of the compulsory course, exercises, seminars, evaluated students, including at state examinations, supervised and opposed final theses at the second and third level of higher education, participated in designing the study materials, in the development of the quality of study programmes, led gifted students of secondary schools and universities in subject clubs or competitions (e.g. subject Olympiads, high-school professional activities, student scientific professional activities, artistic activities), led a team in educational development projects.
2. Demonstration that the applicant has participated in the development of education or a study programme through the outputs of pedagogical activity in the form of the creation of study materials (university textbook or chapter in a university textbook, teaching material, lecture materials or textual aid, educational film, e-learning course containing the content, distribution and management component of instruction in the relevant field of study, introduction of new units into the study programme, teaching software, and teaching aids).
3. Demonstration of some other relevant activities related to education, e.g. by membership of professional committees, bodies and councils focused on higher education, lecture stays abroad of the total of at least 20 days (e.g. ERASMUS mobility – teaching), organization or professional guarantee of educational activities (workshop, exhibition, field trip, etc.), demonstrating the development of language, pedagogical or digital skills and competences, creating teaching case studies, awards for pedagogical activity, involvement in lifelong learning, conducting accredited courses, etc.).
4. The minimum threshold values of measurable indicators by individual fields of habilitation and inauguration proceedings are set out in Annex 1 hereto.

**PART III**

**CREATIVE ACTIVITY  
AT INDIVIDUAL PARTS OF UPJŠ IN KOŠICE**

**A) Creative activity at the Faculty of Medicine of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice**

1. The following criteria are required to be fulfilled regarding creative activity:
  - a) experience and results regarding creative activity, in particular: leading research or artistic teams, organizing scientific or artistic events, solving research tasks, implementing technical or artistic projects, patents and certificates of authorship, inventions and technical works, performing research, development, artistic or other creative activities in the workplace and publishing the results in the form of scientific works or artistic outputs or artistic performances or other outputs of creative activity in the number, structure, scope, intensity, degree of authorial contribution, and quality corresponding to international standards and particularities in the relevant field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings;
  - b) influence on the development of the relevant field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings by creating a scientific school or art school or an original, generally recognized group that builds on the outputs of their creative activity, at least by training and supervising doctoral students in the field of study to which the field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings is assigned;
  - c) demonstration that the applicant is recognized as a scientific authority in professional circles or as an artistic authority in artistic circles in the relevant field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings, their scientific works or works of art or artistic performances have also achieved international recognition, for example by completing lecture stays abroad, but especially by demonstrating responses to scientific publications or artistic outputs and performances or other outputs of creative activity in the number, structure and other attributes corresponding to international standards and particularities in the relevant field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings (responses also from abroad are required, self-citations are excluded);
2. The minimum threshold values of measurable indicators by individual fields of habilitation and inauguration proceedings are set out in Annex 1 hereto. Published scientific works or artistic outputs or artistic performances or other outputs of creative activity and responses to published scientific works or artistic outputs or performances or other outputs of creative activity are documented by an extract from the academic library certified by a responsible employee thereof.

**B) Creative activity at the Faculty of Science of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice**

1. The following criteria are required to be fulfilled for creative activity:
  - a) experience and results regarding creative activity, in particular: leading research teams, organizing scientific events, solving research tasks, implementing technical projects, patents and certificates of authorship, inventions and technical works, performing research, development, or other creative activities and publishing the results in the form of scientific works or other outputs of creative activity in the number, structure, scope, intensity, degree of authorial contribution, and quality corresponding to international standards and particularities in the relevant field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings;
  - b) influence on the development of the relevant field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings by creating a scientific school or an original, generally recognized group that builds on the outputs of their creative activity, at least by training and supervising doctoral students in the field of study to which the field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings is assigned;
  - c) demonstration that the applicant is recognized as a scientific authority in professional circles or as an artistic authority in artistic circles in the relevant field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings, their scientific works have also achieved international recognition, for example by completing lecture stays abroad, but especially by demonstrating responses to published scientific works or other outputs of creative

activity in the number, structure and other attributes corresponding to international standards and particularities in the relevant field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings (responses also from abroad are required, self-citations are excluded).

2. The minimum threshold values of measurable indicators by individual fields of habilitation and inauguration proceedings are set out in Annex 1. Published scientific works or other outputs of creative activity and responses to published scientific works or other outputs of creative activity are documented by an extract from the UPJŠ University Library certified by a responsible employee thereof. In the case of higher education institutions that are contributors to the Central Register of Publication Activities, it is the output from the relevant academic library verified by the Vice-Dean whose competence is the scientific and research activities of the faculty, or by the Dean of the relevant faculty of the university. In the case of other applicants whose publication activities and responses are processed on the basis of a bibliographic registration contract, it is an extract from the UPJŠ University Library certified by a responsible employee thereof.

**C) Creative activity at the Faculty of Law of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice**

1. The following criteria are required to be fulfilled regarding creative activity:
  - a) experience and results regarding creative activity corresponding to the defined area of science and education, in particular: leading research teams, organizing scientific events, solving research tasks, implementing research, development or other creative activities in the workplace and publishing the results in the form of scientific works or other outputs of creative activity in the number, structure, scope, intensity, degree of authorial contribution, and quality corresponding to international standards and particularities in the relevant field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings
  - b) influence on the development of the defined area of science and education by creating a scientific school or an original, generally recognized group that builds on the outputs of their creative activity, at least by training and supervising doctoral students in the field of study corresponding to the defined area of science and education;
  - c) demonstration that the applicant is recognized as a scientific authority in professional circles in the relevant defined area of science and education, their scientific works have also achieved international recognition, for example by completing lecture stays abroad, but especially by demonstrating responses to published scientific works or other outputs of creative activity in the number, structure and other attributes corresponding to international standards and particularities in the defined area of science and education (responses also from abroad are required, self-citations are excluded).
2. The minimum threshold values of measurable indicators for creative activity are set out in the table in Annex 1 hereto.

**D) Creative activity at the Faculty of Arts of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice**

1. The following criteria are required to be fulfilled regarding creative activity:
  - a) experience and results regarding creative activity, in particular: leading research teams, organizing scientific events, solving research tasks, implementing research, development or other creative activities in the workplace and publishing the results in the form of scientific works or other outputs of creative activity in the number, structure, scope, intensity, degree of authorial contribution, and quality corresponding to international standards and particularities in the relevant field of habilitation and

inauguration proceedings;

- b) influence on the development of the relevant field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings by creating a scientific school or an original, generally recognized group that builds on the outputs of their creative activity, at least by training and supervising doctoral students in the field of study to which the field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings is assigned;
  - c) demonstration that the applicant is recognized as a scientific authority in professional circles in the relevant field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings, their scientific works have also achieved international recognition, for example by completing lecture stays abroad, but especially by demonstrating responses to published scientific works or other outputs of creative activity in the number, structure and other attributes corresponding to international standards and particularities in the relevant field of habilitation and inauguration proceedings (responses also from abroad are required, self-citations are excluded).
2. The minimum threshold values of measurable indicators by individual fields of habilitation and inauguration proceedings are set out in Annex 1 hereto. Published scientific works or other outputs of creative activity and responses to published scientific works or other outputs of creative activity are documented by an extract from the UPJŠ University Library certified by a responsible employee thereof. In the case of employees of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice, it is an extract from the UPJŠ University Library certified by a responsible employee thereof. In the case of higher education institutions that are contributors to the Central Register of Publication Activities, it is the output from the relevant academic library verified by the Vice-Dean whose competence is the scientific and research activities of the faculty, or by the dean of the relevant faculty of the university. In the case of other applicants whose publication activities and responses are processed on the basis of a bibliographic registration contract, it is an extract from the UPJŠ University Library certified by a responsible employee thereof.

#### **PART IV**

##### **APPLICATION FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE SELECTION PROCEDURE AT INDIVIDUAL PARTS OF UPJŠ IN KOŠICE**

#### **A) Application at the Faculty of Medicine of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice**

- 1. The applicant submits for the selection procedure a professional curriculum vitae, officially certified copies of documents proving the attained level of education, documents confirming the award of scientific-pedagogical and academic titles, and documents proving fulfilment of the criteria for filling the functional position of professor under Annex 2: An overview of fulfilment of the criteria for filling the functional position of professor.
- 2. The applicant is required to provide evidence of meeting the criteria by submitting, depending on the type of criterion, confirmation of the period of educational activity, a list of publications and responses thereto in a structure that allows verification of fulfilment of individual criteria, confirmation of participation in research and other projects.

#### **B) Application at the Faculty of Science of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice**

- 1. The applicant submits for the selection procedure a professional curriculum vitae, officially certified copies of documents proving the attained level of education, documents confirming the award of scientific-pedagogical and academic titles, documents proving active participation in conferences, research stays/internships, and documents proving fulfilment of the criteria for filling the functional position of professor under Annex 1: An overview of fulfilment of the criteria for filling the functional position of professor. The applicant also indicates the fulfilment of individual criteria for the past



five years.

2. The applicant is required to provide evidence of meeting the criteria by submitting, depending on the type of criterion, confirmation of the period of educational activity, a list of publications and responses thereto in a structure that allows verification of fulfilment of individual criteria, confirmation of participation in research and other projects.

**C) Application at the Faculty of Law of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice**

1. The applicant for the functional position of professor submits an application for participation in the selection procedure, which contains:
  - a) the applicant's name, surname, titles, permanent residence address, date of birth,
  - b) specification of the functional position being applied for,
  - c) a list of documents and attachments enclosed with the application.
2. The application for the functional position of professor must be accompanied by:
  - a) a structured professional curriculum vitae,
  - b) officially certified copies of documents confirming the level of attained education and the awarded scientific-pedagogical or scientific-qualification degrees (except for applicants employed at the faculty and these documents are already a part of the applicant's personal file),
  - c) a declared overview of fulfilment of the criteria for obtaining the scientific-pedagogical title of professor as specified in the standards for habilitation proceedings and inauguration proceedings,
  - d) certificate issued by a higher education institution confirming the performance of pedagogical activity for the period complying with the minimum requirement (except for applicants employed at the faculty),
  - e) an overview of previous pedagogical activity and the results achieved, including a list of supervised doctoral students,
  - f) a list of all registered publication outputs of the applicant and responses thereto,
  - g) an overview of previous creative activity and the results achieved,
  - h) an overview of the applicant's recognition in professional circles and of the applicant's international recognition,
  - i) a sworn declaration that, upon taking up the position, the applicant is not employed by another higher education institution in the position of rector, vice-rector, dean, vice-dean, senior staff member, or in a similar role at a higher education institution abroad, and that the applicant is not a person responsible for a study programme at another higher education institution.

**D) Application at the Faculty of Arts of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice**

1. The applicant submits for the selection procedure a professional curriculum vitae, officially certified copies of documents proving the attained level of education, documents confirming the award of scientific-pedagogical and academic titles, and documents proving fulfilment of the criteria for filling the functional position of professor under Annex 1.
2. The applicant is required to provide evidence of meeting the criteria by submitting, depending on the type of criterion, confirmation of the period of educational activity, a list of publications and responses thereto in a structure that allows verification of fulfilment of individual criteria, confirmation of participation in research and other projects.

**E) Application at the Faculty of Public Administration of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice**

1. The applicant for the functional position of professor submits an application for participation in the selection procedure, which contains:
  - a) the applicant's name, surname, titles, permanent residence address, date of birth,
  - b) specification of the functional position being applied for,

- c) a list of documents and attachments enclosed with the application.
- 2. The application for the functional position of professor must be accompanied by:
  - a) a structured professional curriculum vitae,
  - b) officially certified copies of documents confirming the level of attained education and the awarded scientific-pedagogical or scientific-qualification degrees (except for applicants employed at this faculty and these documents are already a part of the applicant's personal file),
  - c) the applicant is required to provide evidence of meeting the criteria by submitting, depending on the type of criterion, confirmation of the period of educational activity, a list of publications and responses thereto in a structure that allows verification of fulfilment of individual criteria, confirmation of participation in research and other projects,
  - d) a sworn declaration that, upon taking up the position, the applicant is not employed by another higher education institution in the position of rector, vice-rector, dean, vice-dean, senior staff member, or in a similar role at a higher education institution abroad, and that the applicant is not a person responsible for a study programme at another higher education institution.

#### **F) Application at the Institute of Physical Education and Sport of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice**

- 1. The applicant for the functional position of professor submits an application for participation in the selection procedure, which contains:
  - a) the applicant's name, surname, titles, permanent residence address, date of birth,
  - b) specification of the functional position being applied for,
  - c) a list of documents and attachments enclosed with the application.
- 2. The application for the functional position of professor must be accompanied by:
  - a) a structured professional curriculum vitae,
  - b) officially certified copies of documents confirming the level of attained education and the awarded scientific-pedagogical or scientific-qualification degrees,
  - c) the applicant is required to provide evidence of meeting the criteria by submitting, depending on the type of criterion, confirmation of the period of educational activity, a list of publications and responses thereto in a structure that allows verification of fulfilment of individual criteria, confirmation of participation in research and other projects,
  - d) a sworn declaration that, upon taking up the position, the applicant is not employed by another higher education institution in the position of rector, vice-rector, dean, vice-dean, senior staff member, or in a similar role at a higher education institution abroad, and that the applicant is not a person responsible for a study programme at another higher education institution.

### **PART V FINAL PROVISIONS**

#### **Article I**

- 1. These Conditions for Filling the Functional Positions of Professors were approved by the Scientific Board of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice on 19 June 2025 on the proposal of the Scientific Board of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University, Faculty of Medicine (FM), Faculty of Science (FS), Faculty of Law (FL), Faculty of Public Administration (FPA), and Faculty of Arts (FA). The Scientific Board of UPJŠ FM discussed these conditions on 9 June 2025, the Scientific Board of UPJŠ FS discussed

these conditions on 10 June 2025, the Scientific Board of UPJŠ FL discussed these criteria on 10 June 2025, the Scientific Board of UPJŠ FPA discussed these conditions on 11 June 2025, and the Scientific Board of UPJŠ FA discussed these criteria on 13 June 2025.

2. These Conditions for Filling the Functional Positions of Professors become valid and effective on the day of their signing by the Rector of UPJŠ in Košice.
3.
