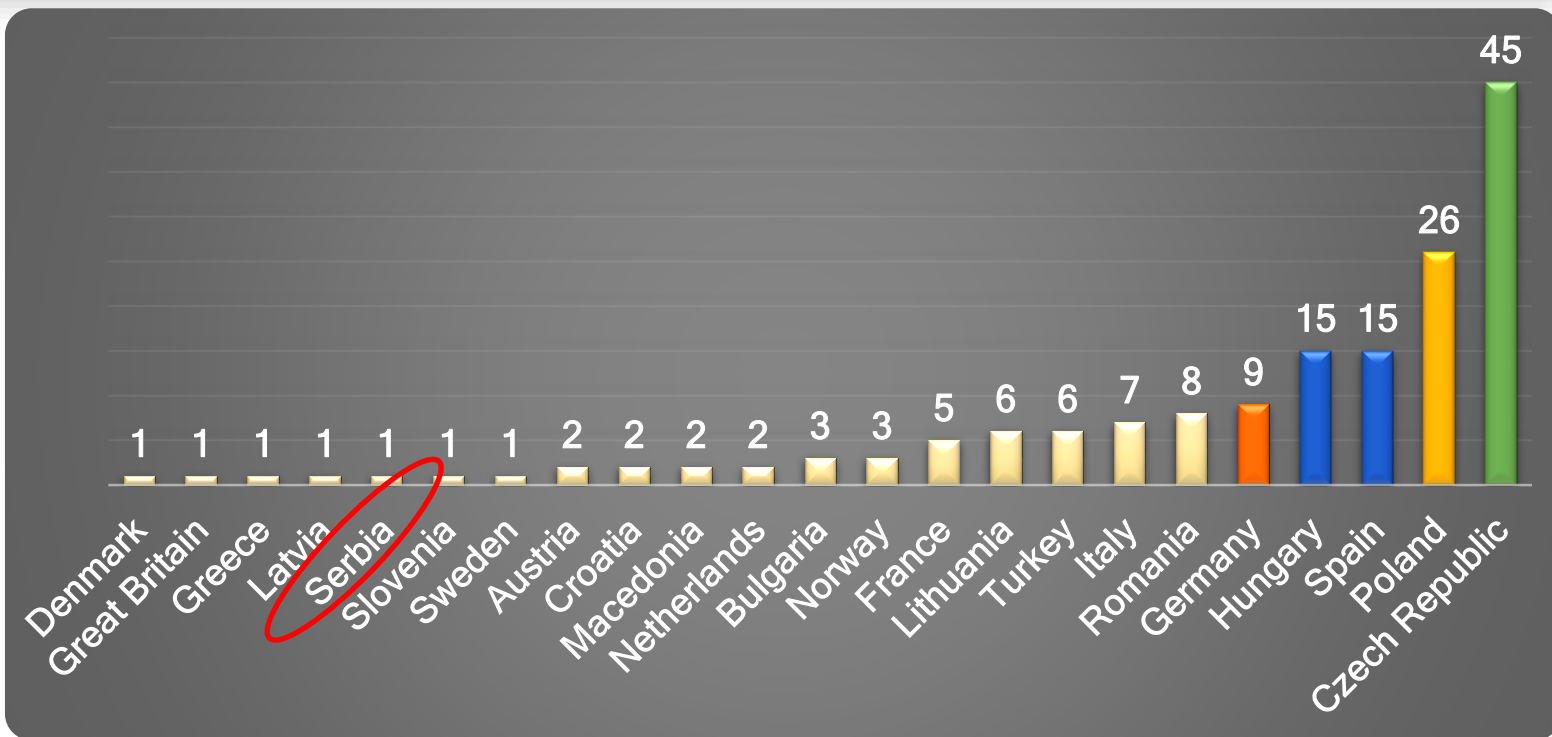

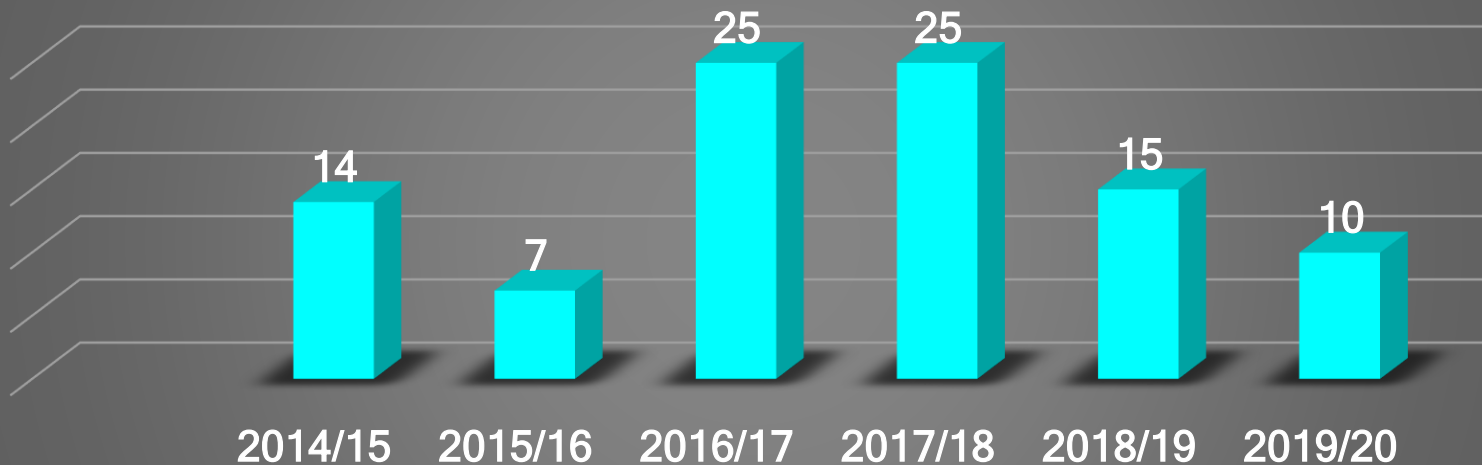

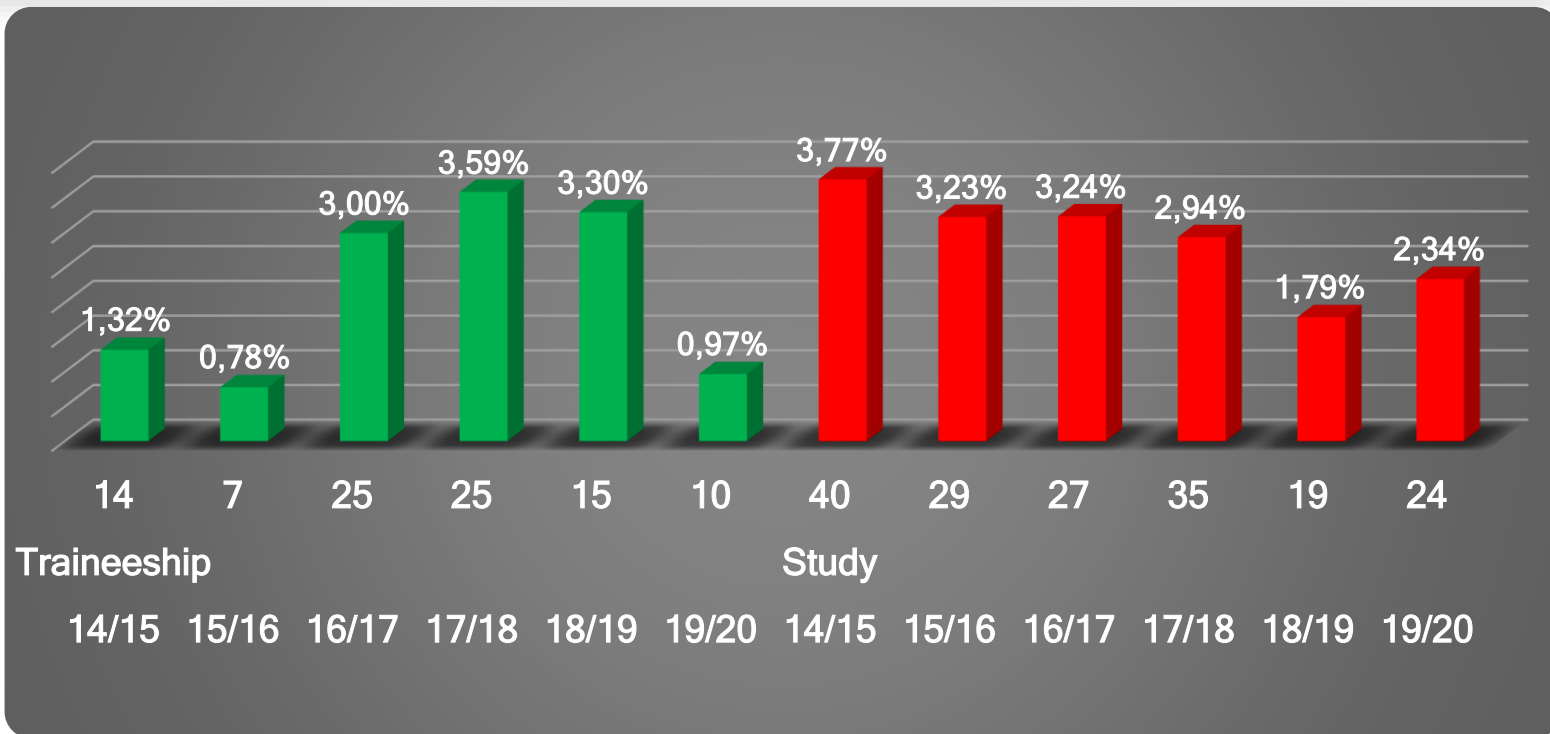

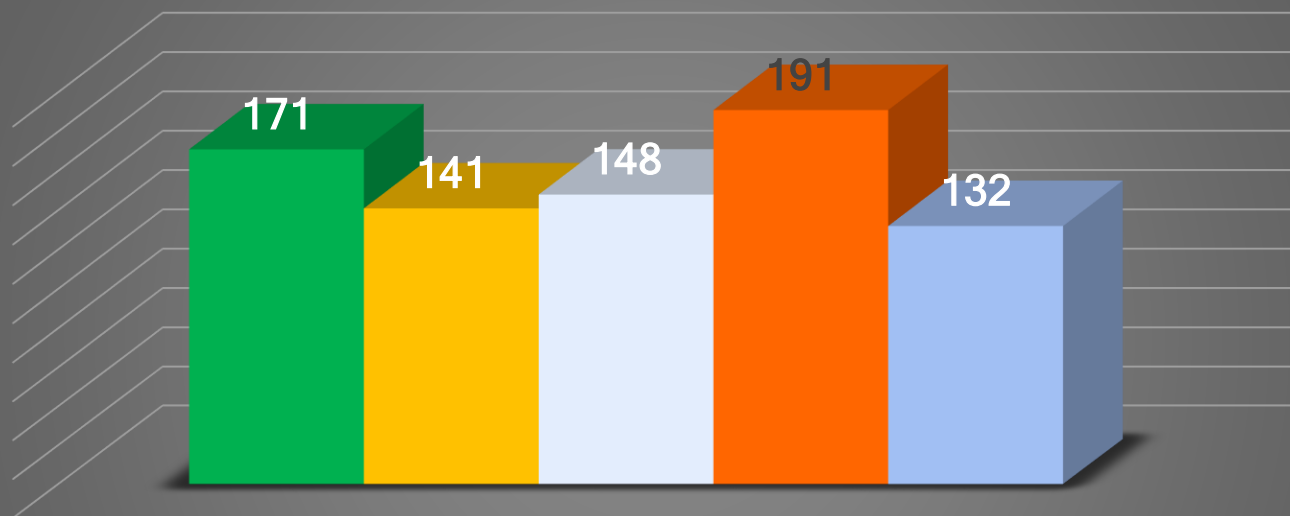

## Business Trips Abroad in 2015 - 2019

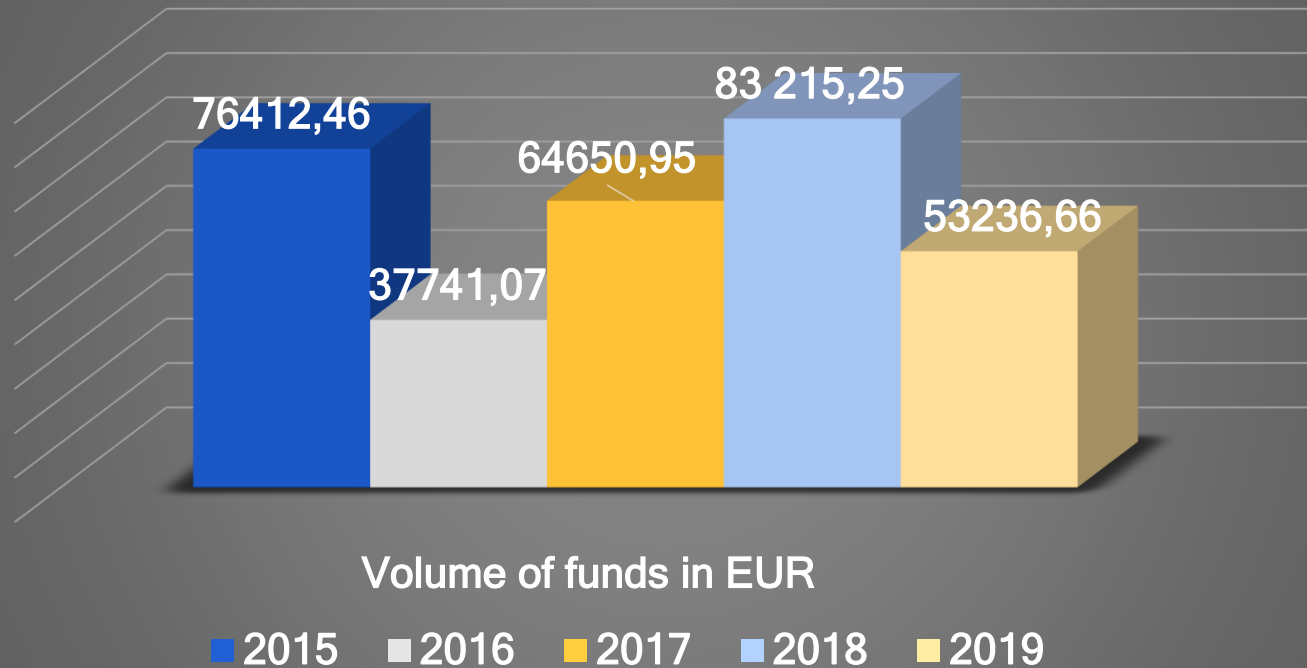


Number of bussines trips abroad

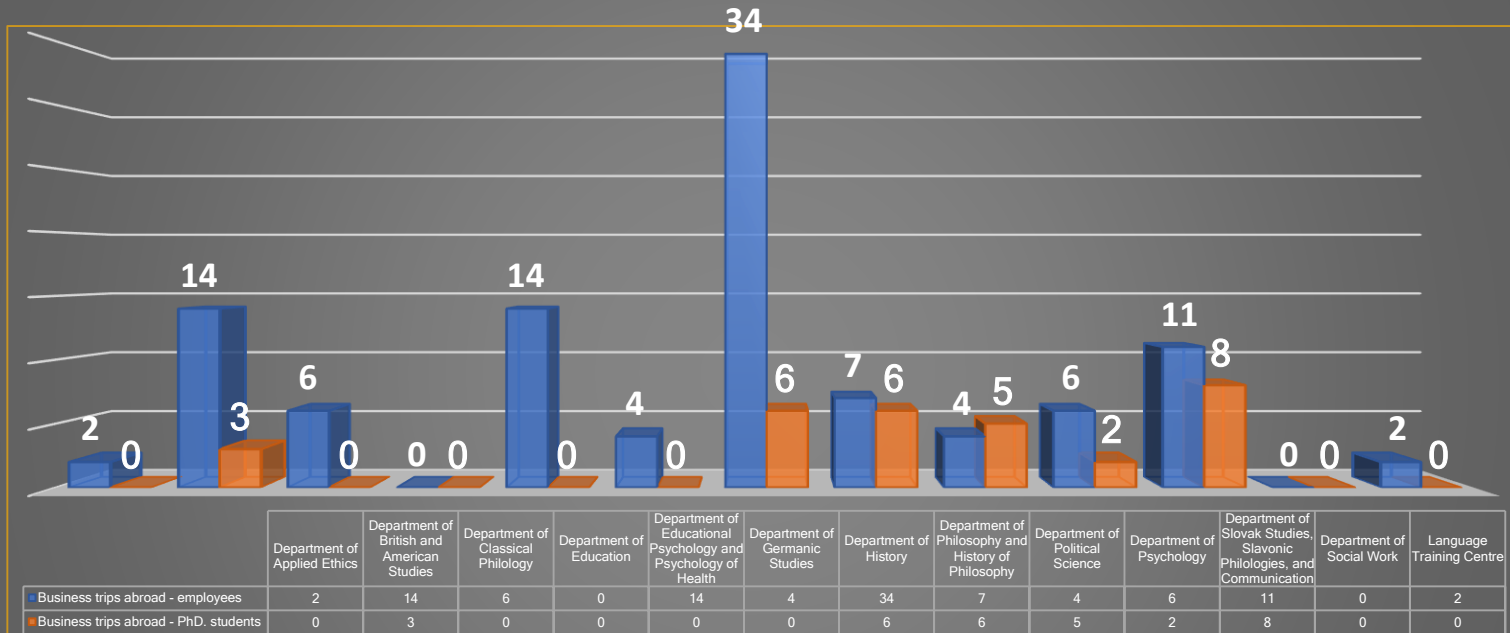


## Travel Reimbursements in 2015-2019
