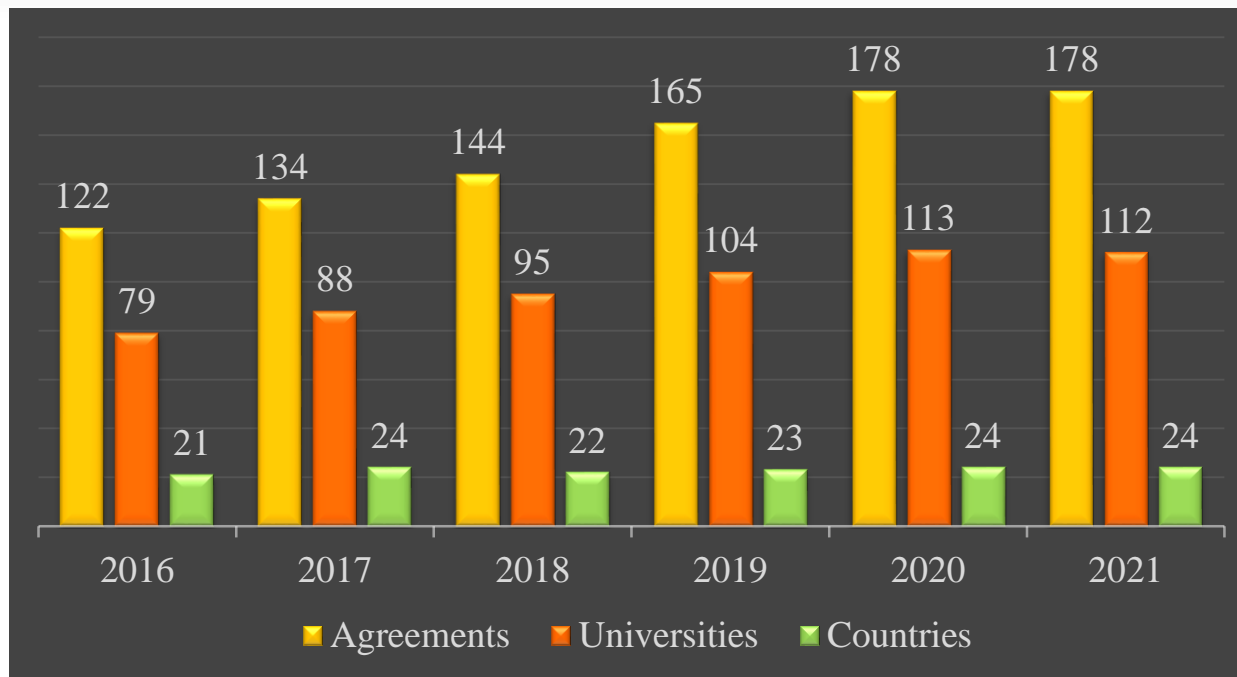

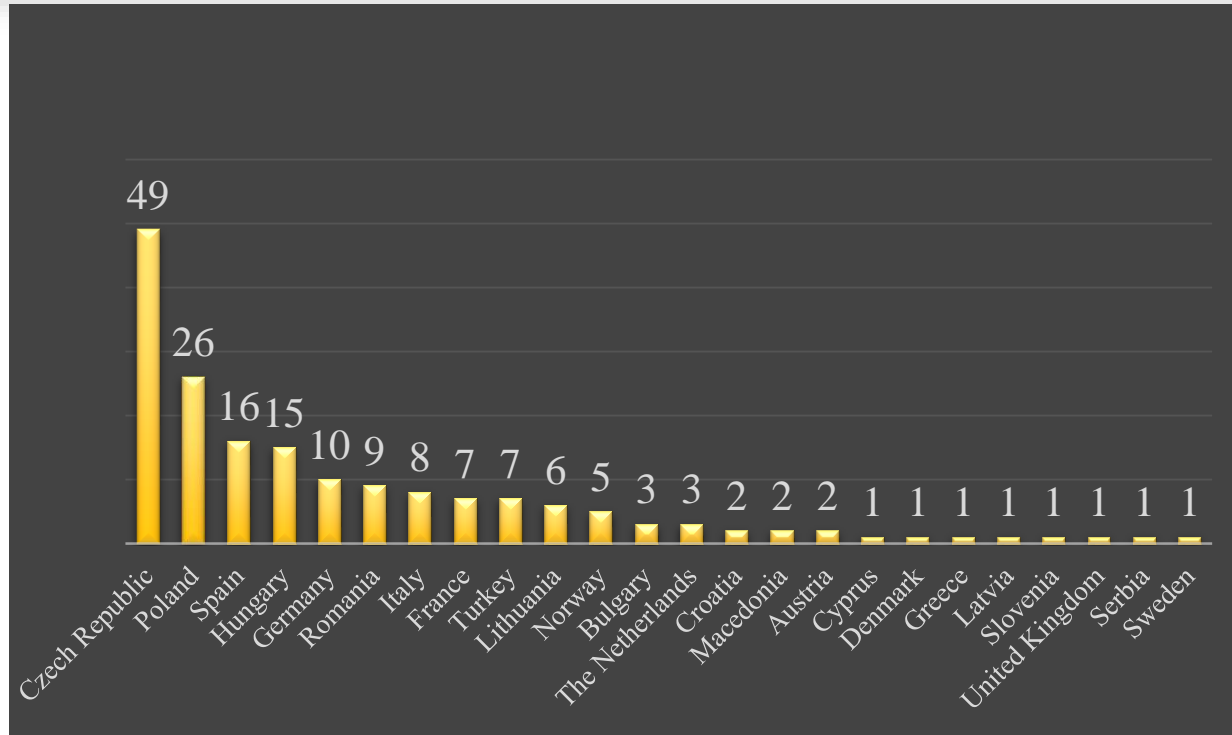


Erasmus+ KA 131 Agreements

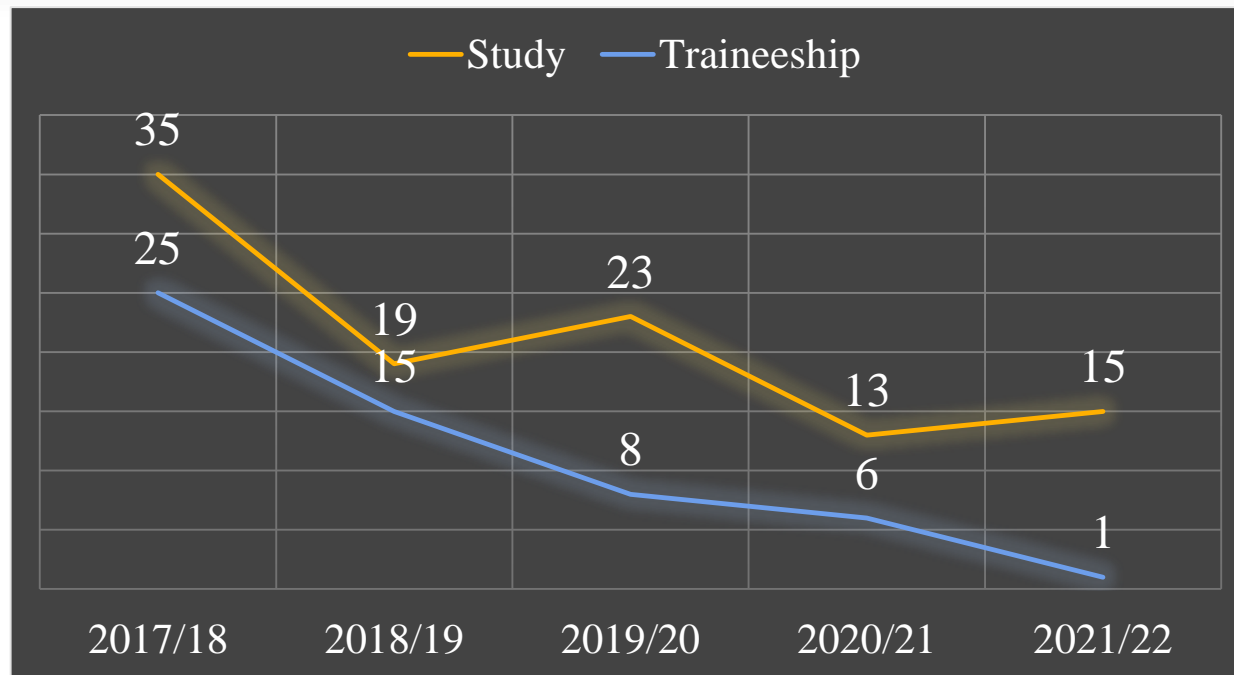
