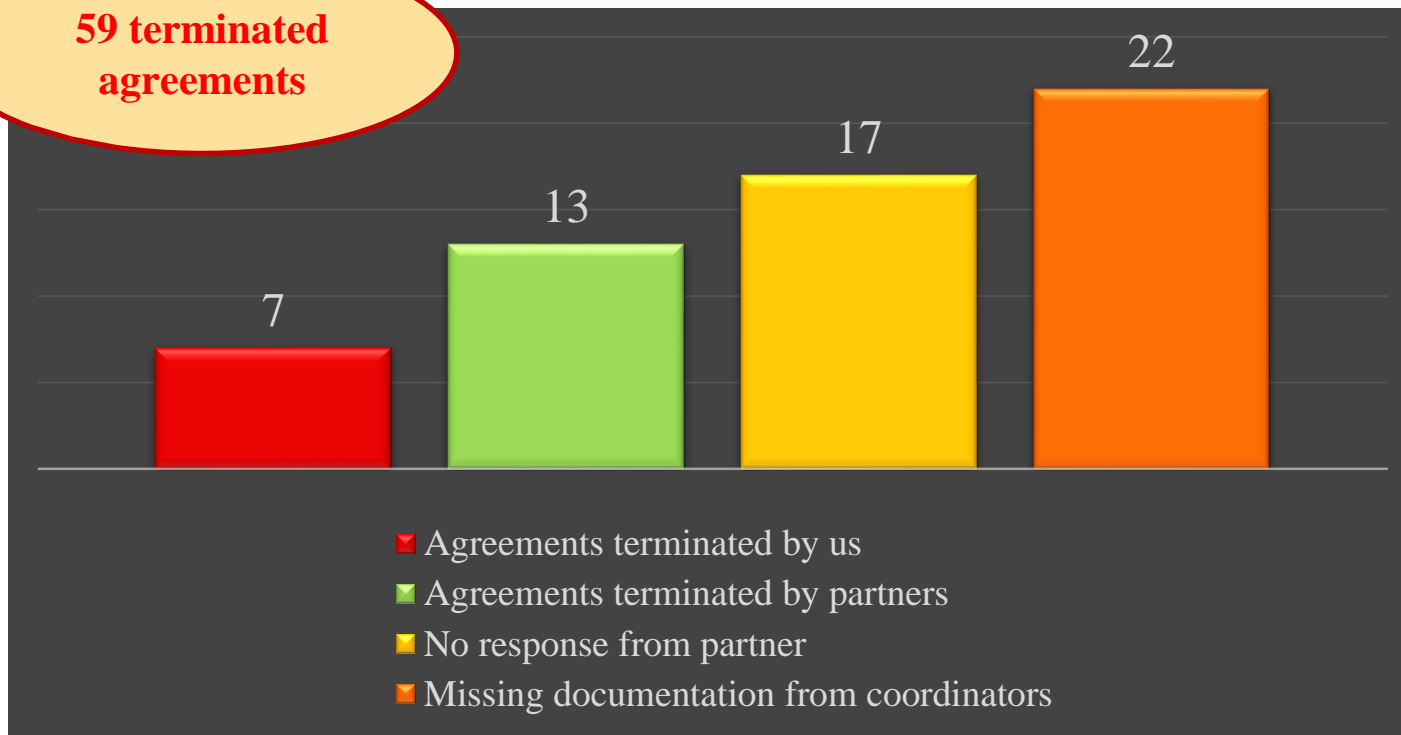

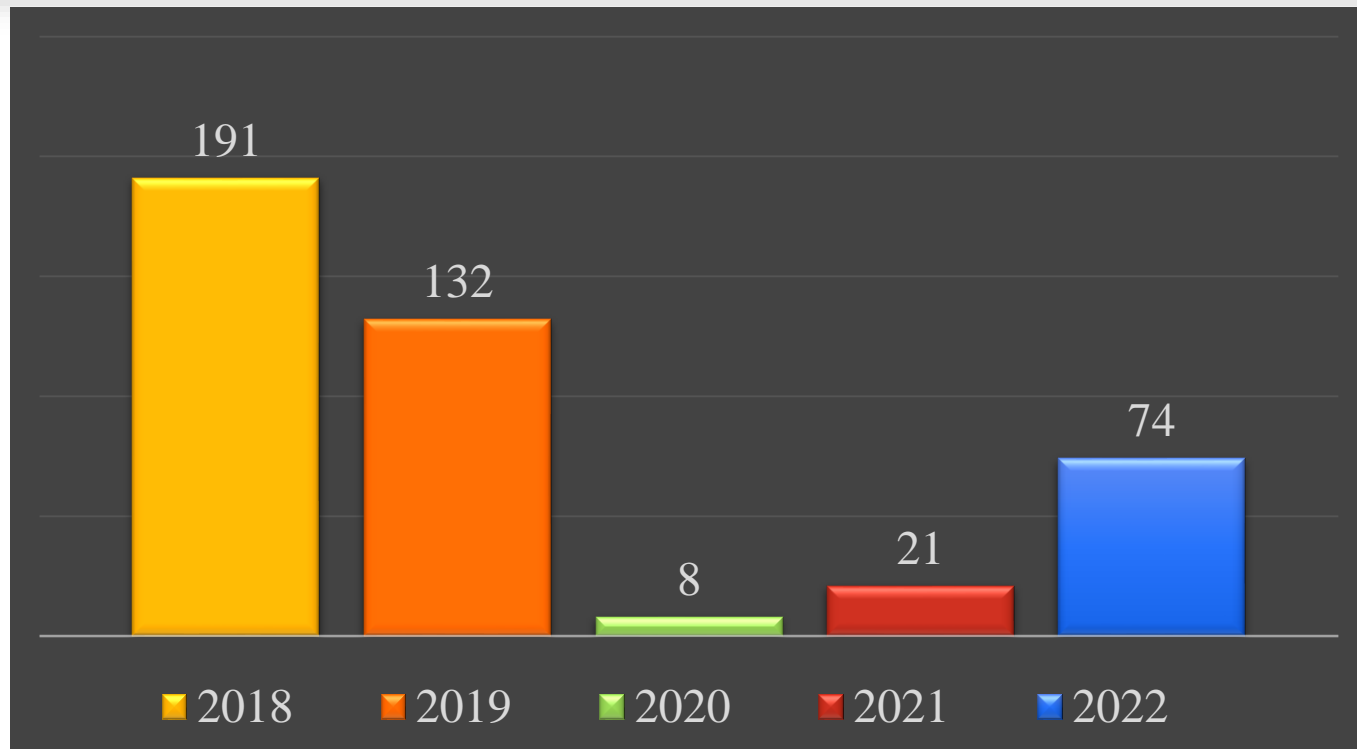

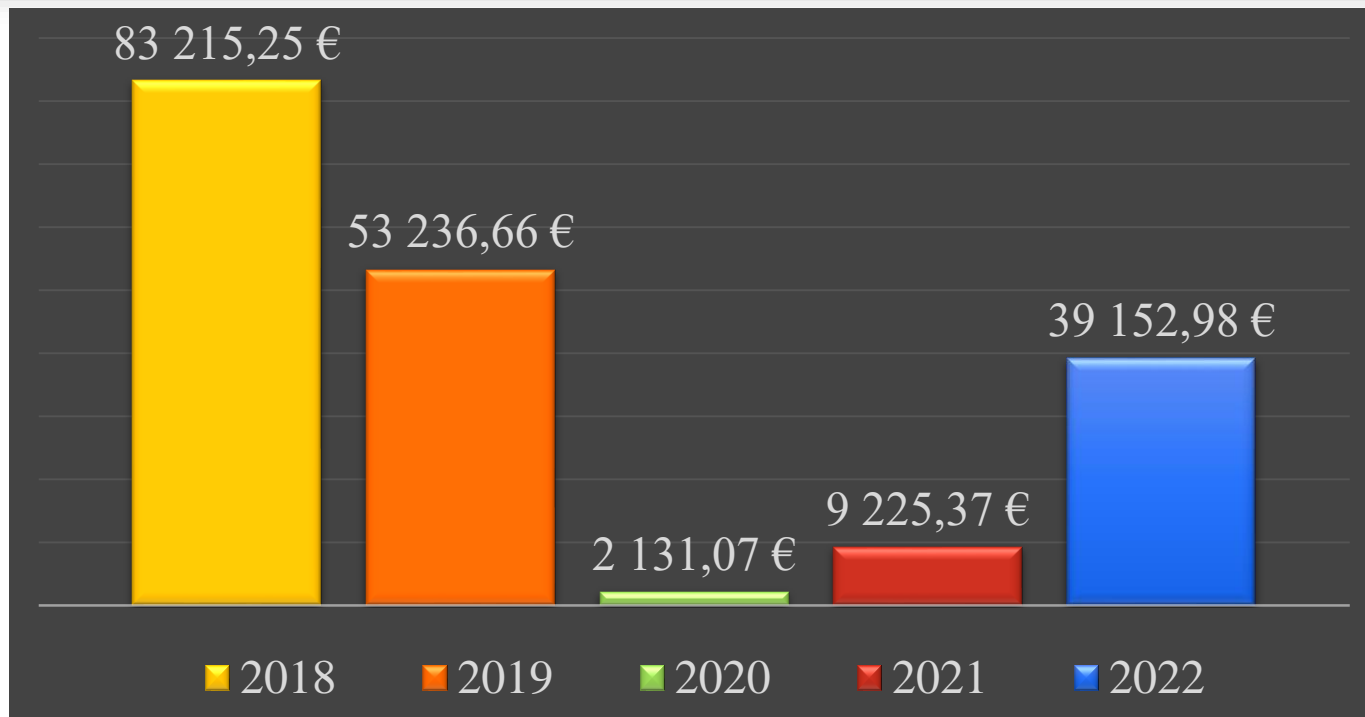


Business Trips Abroad in 2018 - 2022
